### Fund Update for the quarter ending 30 September 2016

This Fund Update is a replacement Fund Update and replaces the one previously published on 21 October 2016 due to additional statements regarding currency hedging policy. This Fund Update was made publicly available on 17 February 2017.

#### What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Russell LifePoints® Growth Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds. Aon Saver Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013.

This information is not audited and may be updated.

#### Description of this Fund

The Russell LifePoints® Growth Fund aims to produce returns well in excess of inflation with a medium to high level of risk. It has a target asset mix of 25% income and 75% growth.

#### What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Russell LifePoints® Growth Fund.

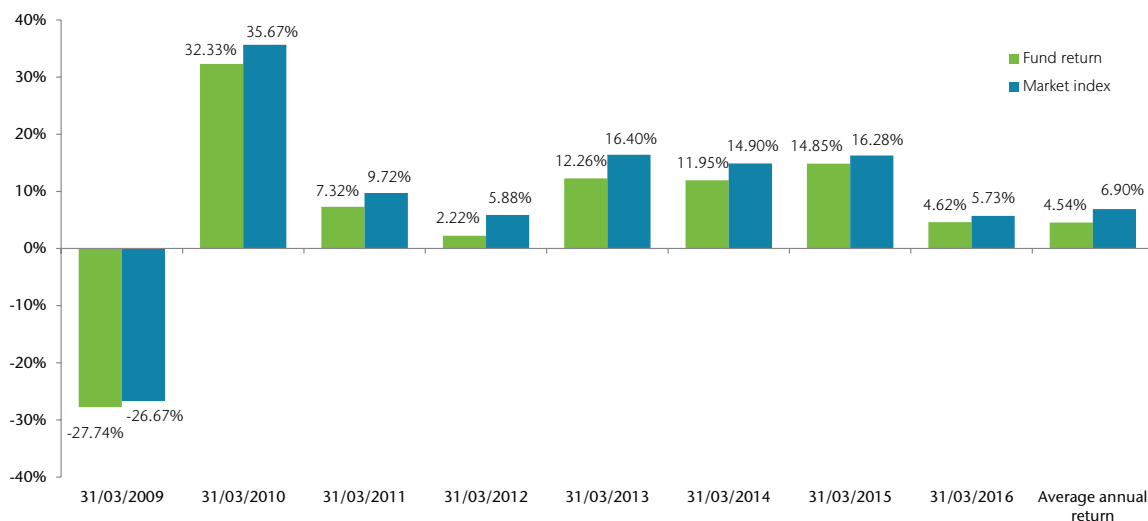
#### How has the Fund performed?

\* Annual membership fees are the fixed dollar charges for membership in the Aon KiwiSaver Scheme, paid monthly. You will pay this fee only once each month even if you are invested in multiple funds within the Aon KiwiSaver Scheme. If you are under 18 this fee is reduced to \$40.

Investors may also be charged individual action fees for specific actions or decisions (for example, for withdrawing from or switching funds). Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

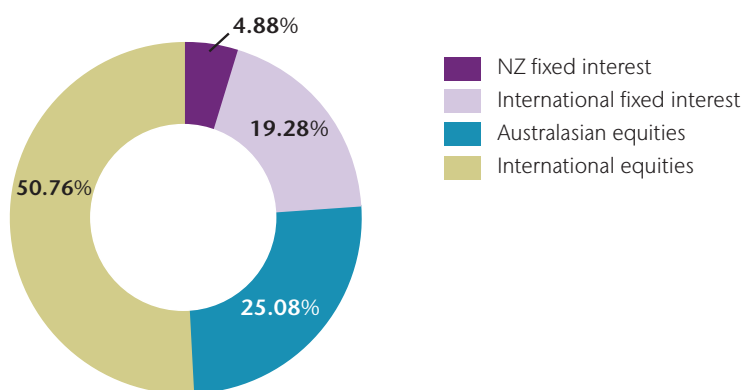
## Example of how this applies to an investor

Jacob had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Jacob received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$1,046 (that's 10.46% of his initial \$10,000). Jason also paid \$49.80 in membership fees. This gives Jacob a total return of \$996.20 for the year.

### Currency hedging

Currency hedging can apply to some of the asset classes this fund invests in.

The targeted level of currency hedging for international equities is 50%. Other global asset classes target a 100% hedge to the New Zealand dollar.
