Aon - Nikko Balanced Fund (formerly Tyndall Balanced Fund)

What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the Aon KiwiSaver Scheme Aon - Nikko Balanced Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Aon - Nikko Balanced Fund provides an active and diversified exposure to major New Zealand and international asset classes. The fund's objective is to give rates of return in excess of inflation appropriate for a long term investment strategy for retirement.

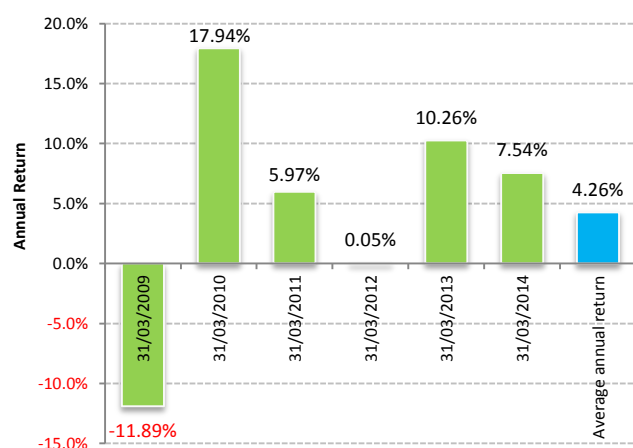
How has the fund performed?

What fees were members charged?

The returns above are after deductions for **fund fees**². These fees were last totalled up for the year to 31 March 2014 and were:

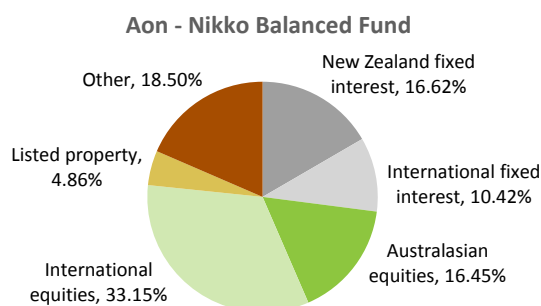
Example of how this applies to a member

Jason had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Jason received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$1,012 (that's 10.12% of his initial \$10,000). Jason also paid \$49.80 in membership fees. This gives Jason a total return of \$962.20 for the year.

⁵ These investments are made under the 18% target asset allocation to "Other" and the Nikko Option Fund. See note 4 above.

⁶ The key personnel named are employed by Nikko Asset Management Limited, not the Manager of the Aon KiwiSaver Scheme.

⁷ The Aon - Nikko Balanced Fund does not have any trade allocation or proxy voting policies. For trade execution, assets are invested/redeemed at benchmark asset allocations. Assets are reweighted to benchmark asset allocations if they exceed +/- 5.0%.
